Re: Medication Policy

Please review the St. Robert Medication Policy. This policy is in existence for the well being of all students and not intended to inconvenience. Students **may not** bring and administer their own medication in school. This is a safety hazard to your child and other children.

Medication Policy

State of Michigan school code requires that all medicines given at school shall have a **parent permission and doctors order form, including dosage, signed and on file** at school in order to administer the medication. This includes all over-the-counter medication such as Tylenol, cough medicines, nasal spray, etc. Forms are available in the school office. The doctor and parent information may also be faxed to the school office.

Medication must come to school in its original container. (No medicine in baggies or cellophane wrappers).

Inhalers – Students may possess and use metered dose or dry powder inhalers for the relief of asthma symptoms while at school, on school-sponsored transportation, or any school-sponsored activity when APPROVED BY A PHYSICIAN AND REQUESTED IN WRITING FROM STUDENT'S PARENT/GUARDIAN.

This policy is in compliance with State of Michigan School Code.
